

BYLAW 6-1994

A BYLAW REGULATING SNOW REMOVAL
FROM PRIVATE PROPERTY ONTO TOWN PROPERTY

WHEREAS the Town of Southey is permitted by Subsection (g) of section 157 of the Urban Municipality Act which prevents the encumbering of streets and compelling the removal of any obstruction from a street by the person depositing it at his expense;

NOW THEREFORE, the Town of Southey in the Province of Saskatchewan hereby enacts as follows:

1. That no person shall put snow from private property (driveways, sidewalks, etc.) onto town property.
2. That no person shall push snow from the front of their property to the front of neighboring property.
3. Any person found guilty of this infraction shall be liable for the cost of the snow removal from the town property or to the penalty provided in the general penalty bylaw of the town.
