BYLAW NO. 6-2019

GENERAL PENALTY BYLAW

The Council of the Town of Southey in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw shall be known and referred to as the General Penalty Bylaw of the Town.
- 2. Section 3 shall apply only to an infraction of a bylaw of the Town for which no other fine is provided and which, such bylaw states, shall incur the fines herein provided.
- 3. Subject to the provisions of section 2, any person found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the town, passed by authority of the Municipality Act, shall be liable to a fine of not less than \$100 (one hundred) dollars nor more than \$1000(one thousand) dollars and costs for every offence, and in default of payment, the offender will be charges in court.
- 4. All fines imposed for an infraction of a bylaw shall, unless otherwise provided for, belong to the Town of Southey for public use and form part of the general revenue of the Town of Southey.

5. Bylaw No. 10. 1982 (4-67) is repealed.
