Covid-19:

Our current restrictions have been extended to February 19, 2021. Please ensure you are following the guidelines mandated by Saskatchewan Health Authority and the Provincial Government. All guidelines and up-to-date information can be found on the Government of Saskatchewan website (www.saskatchewan.ca). Our office remains open to the public. However, you can make payments online through your online banking, via e-transfer, mail your payment or drop off a cheque in the mail slot located near the front door.

Bylaws:

Council has been working on updating several bylaws. At the January 26th Regular Meeting, Council discussed the following regarding Town of Southey Bylaws:

- **Bylaw 2021-01 – Regulate and Control the Ownership and Possession of Cats:** Council completed the 1st and 2nd reading of the updated bylaw. The 3rd reading will be completed at the February 9th meeting. Please keep in mind, cat owners shall not at any time allow the cat to run at large within the municipality.
- **Bylaw 2021-02 – Amend Zoning Bylaw 01-2019 Known as the Zoning Bylaw:** Council completed the 1st reading of the zoning bylaw amendment and set a **Public Hearing date of February 23rd, 2021 @ 7:10 pm at the Southey Hall.** This bylaw adds “Cannabis Retail Outlets” as a Discretionary Use in the Downtown Commercial District – C1. The Town of Southey received an application to amend the Zoning Bylaw to allow Cannabis Retail Outlets. This application will be considered at the February 23rd Regular Council Meeting. Please see the website for more information and the Public Notice.
- A few of the other bylaws Council will be working on updating and implementing: Regulate and Control the Ownership and Possession of Dogs; Control the Ownership of Animals; Council Procedures;

January marks the annual renewal for both Dog and Business Licenses for the Town of Southey. If you require a license, please ensure to renew it ASAP.
