Covid-19:

Our current restrictions have been extended to March 19, 2021. Please ensure you are following the guidelines mandated by Saskatchewan Health Authority and the Provincial Government. All guidelines and up-to-date information can be found on the Government of Saskatchewan website (www.saskatchewan.ca). Our office remains open to the public. However, you can make payments online through your online banking, via e-transfer, mail your payment or drop off a cheque in the mail slot located near the front door.

Town of Southey – Licenses:

Both Dog and Business Licenses for the Town of Southey must be renewed. If you require a license, please ensure to renew it ASAP.

Bylaws:

Council passed the following Bylaws during February meetings:

- **Bylaw 2021-01 – Regulate and Control the Ownership and Possession of Cats:** *Owners of cats shall not at any time allow the cat to run at large within the municipality.* The updated bylaw is available on the website.
- **Bylaw 2021-02 – Amend Zoning Bylaw 01-2019 known as the Zoning Bylaw:** The bylaw amendment adds “Cannabis Retail Outlets” as a Discretionary Use in the Downtown Commercial District – C1.
- **Bylaw 2021-03 – Control the Ownership of Animals:** The bylaw adds “No person shall keep more than one (1) “silkie chicken” for any other purpose other than for that of a personal pet. The pet shall be housed indoors and only allowed outside supervised within the homeowner’s property limits.”

Census 2021:

Canada’s next Census of Population will take place in Spring of 2021. Statistics Canada will be hiring in our area in preparation for the 2021 Census. Recruitment information is available on our Website, Facebook page or at www.census.gc.ca.

Health Centre:

The new Health Centre continues to be a busy place with our Health Practitioner Services, Lab Services and Public Health Services. With COVID-19 Fundraising has been put on hold. However, anyone wishing to make a donation can do so at the Town Office. An official Tax Receipt will be issued.

2021 SAMA Revaluation:

SAMA conducts revaluations based on a four-year cycle. 2017 was the year of the last revaluation and the 2021 Revaluation will see assessed values updated to reflect a new base date of January 1, 2019. The legislated base date means that 2021 values reflect a property’s value as of January 1, 2019. For the 2021 Revaluation, all property types will have their values updated in relation to the January 1, 2019 base date. Please ensure you review your assessment when you receive it in April 2021.
