#### **Covid-19:**

Saskatchewan has begun Step 2 of the Re-Opening Roadmap with Step 3 to be implemented by July 11, 2021. We hope all residents continue to take the necessary steps to remain safe and self-monitor should you be experiencing any symptoms.

Our office is open to the public Monday thru Friday from 8:00am to 4:00pm. We accept payments online through your online banking, via e-transfer, mail your payment or drop off a cheque in the mail slot located near the front door.

#### **Property Taxes:**

The 2021 Assessment Roll closed on June 15<sup>th</sup>. Council is in the final process of reviewing our 2021 Budget. A portion of the revenues the Town of Southey operates on is based on municipal property taxes. There will be some change in your 2021 Town of Southey Property Taxes. The following items affect your property taxes:

- 2021 Taxable Assessment – Revaluation Year
- 2021 Provincial Education Tax was increased
- Base Tax and Mill Rate Factors set by the Municipality

You should expect to receive your 2021 Property Taxes before July 31<sup>st</sup>.

#### **Town of Southey Business Licenses:**

Businesses operating within the Town of Southey currently require a Business License with the exception of commercially assessed businesses. If you have a contractor/service provider completing work at your residence; the contractor/service provider is to purchase a business license from the Town of Southey. More times than not, this does not happen.

Council is considering repealing the Business License Bylaw effective 2022 as the bylaw is difficult to enforce and creates very little revenue.

#### **Road Maintenance:**

Weather permitting, Public Works will begin applying emulsion to roads around Town this summer. Please be sure to watch your area for signs. We appreciate your cooperation while this maintenance is being completed.
