Covid-19:

Saskatchewan will begin Step 1 of the Re-Opening Roadmap on May 30, 2021. We hope all residents continue to take the necessary steps to remain safe and self-monitor should you be experiencing any symptoms.

Our office is currently open to the public. We accept payments online through your online banking, via e-transfer, mail your payment or drop off a cheque in the mail slot located near the front door.

Landfill Day:

On **Saturday, June 12th** all residents of the Town of Southey are invited to haul any household waste **FREE** of charge to the Touchwood Hills Regional Landfill. The Landfill will be open from 9:00am to 3:00pm.

RECYCLABLE ITEMS: electronics, batteries (single use alkaline, rechargeable)

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED IN LANDFILL PIT: metal, white goods (stove, dryer, deep freeze, fridge – all items must be free of freon)

PROHIBITED ITEMS: paint, tires, railway ties, oil, barb wire

Sewer Jetting:

Atlas Sewer Service will be jetting sewer lines in Town on June 7th and 8th. You may experience air in the sewer lines while this service is being completed. This air can cause your toilet to “bubble” or “burp”. This is normal. Please contact the office if you have any questions or concerns.

Bylaw No. 4-2014 – The Burning Bylaw:

As summer approaches, many residents are beginning to enjoy bonfires. Please ensure your bonfire (“open air fire”) follows the Town of Southey “Burning Bylaw”. The bylaw states – open air fires must be contained in a receptacle constructed of cement, brick or metal; have a metal screen with openings not to exceed 10mm; **prohibits** the burning of garbage, leaves, straw, painted wood, treated construction materials and items made of or containing rubber, plastic, tar, material which will create black smoke and/or odor. You can find *The Burning Bylaw* on our website or request a copy from the office to review.

Census 2021:

Accurate and complete census data support programs and services that benefit our community. Many of our Federal and Provincial Grants have been based on the demographic results from the 2016 Census. Future grants will be based on the data collect in 2021. We encourage all residents to complete your 2021 Census as soon as possible. The Census questionnaire can be completed online at www.census.ga.ca.
