

# TOWN OF SOUTHEY

BYLAW NO. 2021-05

## BASE TAX BYLAW

The Council of the Town of Southey, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be known as the "Base Tax Bylaw".
2. A base tax shall apply to the types and classifications of property included in the table below:

Property Class	Type of Property		
	Land	Improvements	Land with Improvement
Residential	\$ 270.00	\$ 630.00	\$ 850.00
Commercial	\$ 270.00	\$ 630.00	\$ 850.00
Agriculture – land not used for agriculture	\$ 270.00		

3. A levy equal to the assessed value of the property multiplied by the mill rate will be added to the base amount of tax.
4. Where a property is classified within more than one property classification by the Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency, the base tax shall be the higher of the applicable classes.
5. Bylaw 2-2010 is hereby repealed.
6. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect of the final date of passing by Council.
