Covid-19:

The Government of Saskatchewan current Public Health Order requires proof of vaccination or negative test for public access to a variety of establishments, businesses and event venues that bring groups of people together. Masking is mandatory in all public buildings. You can find all Public Health Measure information on the Government of Saskatchewan website (www.saskatchewan.ca).

At this time, the Town of Southey has not implemented a Covid-19 Policy for their employees or municipal buildings. Please continue to follow all Provincial Public Health Orders and continue to take the necessary steps to self-monitor should you be experiencing any symptoms.

There are many other groups in Southey looking for members (Lions, Legion, along with other sports/clubs) so if wanting to volunteer in this great community please do not hesitate to reach out.

Public Works:

As we begin to prepare for the upcoming winter weather, we would like to remind residents of our snow removal process. During times of imminent snowfall, our Public Works staff are normally out early to begin clearing snow. This process ensures Keats Street, the school bus route, the paved portion of Tennyson and Highway 99 (if required) are immediately cleared. Public Works staff use their best discretion to continue clearing all other town streets. *If at all possible, please try to avoid parking on streets when Public Works staff is completing snow removal.*

With the Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory that we had in December we are now wanting to initiate a calling system for the public. The only way this could be successful is if we have a current phone number to call for each household. If wanting to be alerted in this manner, please contact the Office either by calling or emailing which number you would like us to call with your current address.
