Covid-19:

The Government of Saskatchewan current Public Health Order requires proof of vaccination or negative test for public access to a variety of establishments, businesses and event venues that bring groups of people together. Masking is mandatory in all public buildings. You can find all Public Health Measure information on the Government of Saskatchewan website (www.saskatchewan.ca).

At this time, the Town of Southey has not implemented a Covid-19 Policy for their employees or municipal buildings. Please continue to follow all Provincial Public Health Orders and continue to take the necessary steps to self-monitor should you be experiencing any symptoms.

Employment Opportunity:

The Town of Southey is currently hiring an Administrator. Property Taxes:

Property Taxes are due on or before December 31st. Any payments received after December 31st are subject to a 12% penalty.

We accept payments online through your online banking, via e-transfer, mail your payment or drop off a cheque in the mail slot located near the front door.

Public Works:

As we begin to prepare for the upcoming winter weather, we would like to remind residents of our snow removal process. During times of imminent snowfall, our Public Works staff are normally out early to begin clearing snow. This process ensures Keats Street, the school bus route, the paved portion of Tennyson and Highway 99 (if required) are immediately cleared. Public Works staff use their best discretion to continue clearing all other town streets. *If at all possible, please try to avoid parking on streets when Public Works staff is completing snow removal.*

Traffic Bylaw:

The Town of Southey Council passed Bylaw 2021-06; a bylaw to Regulate the Operation of Vehicles. This bylaw outlines **parking regulations**, closure of roads, vehicle weight restrictions, etc. This bylaw also outlines the penalties for infractions of the bylaw.
